Operating Rules For Texas Trails Council Properties

1) Check-in & Check-out

- a) Check-in with proper council representative.
- b) Be prepared to show required documentation, Camp permit, Tour & Activity permit, and any other information asked for.
- c) All campsites, equipment, and facilities will be checked before departing for damage, misuse, and cleanliness.
- d) Any Damages, lost equipment, or vandalism to property will be paid before you depart camp.
- e) Cleanliness of camp and facilities is user responsibility, this includes trash.

2) Vehicles

- a) Speed limit is 10 mph on all camp properties unless otherwise posted.
- b) All vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas only, only equipment trailers may remain at campsites.
- c) Do not enter campsite with only motor vehicle for any reason.
- d) Riding in bed of trucks is not allowed.

3) Alcohol, Tobacco, Fireworks, Pets

- a) Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is not allowed and is grounds for immediate dismissal.
- b) Tobacco products are not allowed in camping areas or program areas, their use is limited to designated areas.
- c) Illegal drug use is not permitted and will result in immediate dismissal.
- d) Fireworks are not allowed on council properties, possession will result in immediate dismissal.
- e) Dogs or pets of any kind will not be allowed on camp. Service animals will need credentials.

4) Campfires

- a) Check for burn bans before making a campfire.
- b) Fires in designated fire rings only.
- c) Use only dead wood, do not cut down trees.
- d) Do not dig holes for fires
- e) Make sure fires are completely out and ashes spread.

5. Program Areas

- a) Swimming Pool and Water Front use is subject to the Camp Ranger or designee.
 - All participants must follow rules and regulations set by BSA and Texas Trails Council.
 - Must have trained lifeguards on duty at all times while using these facilities.
- b) Archery Range Must have an adult (21 years or older) to supervise the use of the range and they must be in attendance at all times.
 - Care of equipment is user's responsibility.
 - Damage to equipment will be paid at check-out.
- c) Rifle Range and Shotgun Range Must have an adult (21 years or older) with BSA Shooting Sports Certification in attendance at all times while on the range.
 - No unauthorized weapons will be allowed.
 - All participants and staff must follow the rules.
 - Care of equipment is user's responsibility.
 - Damage to equipment will be paid at check-out.
- <u>d)</u> <u>COPE Area</u> Off limits without certified COPE instructor present.
- e) <u>Climbing and Rappelling Tower</u> Off limits without certified instructor present.
- <u>f)</u> <u>Natural Climbing and Rappelling Wall</u> Off limits without certified instructor present.

5) Liquid Fuel Use

- a) White gas or other flammable material for adult use only.
- b) Youth campers may use LP gas only when necessary.
- c) All liquid fuels must be kept by camp or in unit's designated storage facility.

6) Camp Boundaries

- a) Stay with-in camp boundaries.
- b) Trespassing is illegal and in violation of Scout Law.
- c) Adult leader must accompany any activity on camp property.

We understand that there will be a charge for any lost, damaged, or broken items in our use. As the adult leader in charge, I have read and understand, and will adhere to the regulations for use of Texas Trails Council properties. Failure to adhere may result in immediate dismissal and forfeiting all rights to use Texas Trails Council properties. By signing I agree to all responsibilities set by Texas Trails Council.
